Liberty Counsel Action (LCA), on behalf of more than 750,000 members nationwide, urges you to vote for H.R. 3504, "To prohibit health care practitioner from failing to exercise the proper degree of care in the case of a child who survives an abortion or attempted abortion." LCA seeks to advance religious liberty, the sanctity of human life, the family, limited and responsible government, and support for Israel. LCA will be including your vote in our scorecard for the 114th Congress.

All children deserve to be treated with human dignity, regardless of whether the result of a wanted or unwanted pregnancy. Discriminating against a person, by providing diminished or inferior medical care, because of the circumstance of one's birth is shameful. Unfortunately, in light of recent undercover videos explaining the fetal tissue procurement strategies employed by Planned Parenthood, there is cause for concern pertaining to the treatment of children who survive an abortion procedure.
